

**CALGB 369901: Observational Cohort Study: Chemotherapy Decisions and Outcomes in Women  
Age 65 or Older with Operable, Newly Diagnosed Breast Cancer**

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. Women 65 years or older with operable, newly diagnosed, invasive, unilateral, primary histologically confirmed adenocarcinoma of the breast.
2. English or Spanish speaking.
3. TNM Stage (AJCC Cancer Staging Manual 6<sup>th</sup> Edition):  
T1-4 (Tumor size  $\geq$  1 cm), N0, M0 or T1-4, N1-3, M0
4. All performance status categories
5. Sufficient cognitive function to consent and complete telephone interviews.
6. May be simultaneously enrolled in any other CALGB or non-CALGB clinical trial.
7. Patients should be registered within 4-6 weeks post initial diagnosis but will be accepted for enrollment through 20 weeks after last definitive surgery.
8. No prior history of carcinoma in situ, LCIS, DCIS, or invasive breast cancer. Patients with other malignancies are eligible as long as they have completed treatment and are considered to be at less than 30% risk of relapse. Patients with a history of non-melanoma skin cancer are eligible to participate in the study.
