A211901 - REACHING RURAL CANCER SURVIVORS WHO SMOKE USING TEXT-BASED CESSATION INTERVENTIONS

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Have a cancer diagnosis within the past 10 years.
 - **Note:** Patients with DCIS are eligible and patients currently receiving curative treatment are eligible.
- 2. Not currently on hospice
- 3. Currently smokes ≥ 5 cigarettes daily Note: Participants who vape are eligible.
- 4. Lives in a nonmetro/rural county (defined as having a Rural Urban Continuum Code (RUCC) code of 4-9) and/or a Rural-Urban Communiting Area Code of 4-10 [39]. The RUCC code can be checked at: https://www.ruralhealthinfo.org/am-i-rural.
- 5. Patient interested in participating in a smoking cessation program, and not currently participating in a smoking cessation clinical trial
- 6. Not currently using any smoking cessation pharmacotherapy (e.g., Nicotine Replacement Therapy, bupropion or varenicline), or currently participating in any cessation program at the time of enrollment.
- 7. Patient has a cell phone or smart phone device with texting ability
- 8. **Language:** In order to complete the mandatory patient-completed measures, participants must be able to speak and read English.
- 9. Age ≥ 18 years
- 10. Participant must be willing to provide a urine sample.
- 11. Patients with impaired decision-making capacity are not eligible for this study.


Required Initial Laboratory Values

Eligibility Criteria (see Section 3.2)

- Have a cancer diagnosis within the past 10 years (See §3.2.1).
- Participant not currently on hospice (See §3.2.2)
- Currently smokes ≥ 5 cigarettes daily (See §3.2.3)
- Participant lives in a nonmetro/rural county (See §3.2.4)
- Interested in participating in a smoking cessation program and not currently participating in a smoking cessation trial (See §3.2.5).
- Not using any smoking cessation pharmacotherapy, or participating in any smoking cessation program at the time of enrollment (See §3.2.6)
- Participant has a cell or smart phone device with texting ability (See §3.2.7)
- Participant must be able to speak and read English or Spanish (See §3.2.8)
- Age ≥ 18 years
- Participant must be willing to provide urine sample (See §3.2.10)
- Patients with impaired decision-making capacity are not eligible for this study (See §3.2.11).

- ** NCI's Smokefree.TXT messages will start 2 weeks before quit date and extend for 4 weeks after quit date.
