

## FAST FACTS

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### **EAQ211: Social Genomic Mechanisms of Health Disparities among Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) Survivors of Hodgkin and Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. Patient must be  $\geq 18$  years of age at the time of registration.
2. Patient must have been between the ages of 15-39 at the time of their first primary cancer diagnosis of Hodgkin Lymphoma or Non-Hodgkin lymphoma (NHL).
3. Patient must have completed therapy (with a complete response, per clinician determination) at the time of registration.
4. Patients last date of prior systemic therapy for first primary diagnosis for Hodgkin Lymphoma or Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma must have been within one year prior to registration.  
NOTE: Systemic therapy refers to all anti-cancer therapy, including but not limited to chemotherapy, IV or oral targeted medications, or radiation, and administered via a clinical trial or standard approach.
5. Patient must have an ECOG Performance Status of 0-3.
6. Patient must be English speaking in order to be able to complete the required QOL forms on this study. NOTE: Sites cannot translate the associated QOL forms.
7. Patient must not be receiving active therapy for Hodgkin Lymphoma or Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma.
8. Patient must have internet access through computer, tablet, or smartphone.
9. Patient must have email address.
10. Patient must have the ability to understand and the willingness to sign a written informed consent document. Patients with impaired decision-making capacity (IDMC) who have a legally authorized representative (LAR) or caregiver and/or family member available will also be considered eligible.
